ASA's Minimum Criteria for Known Offenses

- Registered Sex Offender
- Murder
- Manslaughter
- Robbery
- Kidnapping
- Aggravated Assault
- Burglary
- Arson
- Reckless Homicide
- DUI-Three or more in less than 7 years
- Contributing to the delinquency
 Child Pornography of a minor

- Child Seduction
- Criminal Deviate Seduction
- Sexual Misconduct of a Minor
- Child Molestation
- Child Solicitation
- Rape
- Felony and Class A/B Drug Offenses
- Sexual Assault
- Embezzlement
- Felony Theft
- Injury to a Child

Coaches can receive 1 of 2 responses regarding their background check.

- Green Light Approved/All Clear
 - Coaches can proceed with ACE Certification and become ACE Certified
- Yellow or Red Light Not Approved
 - Choicepoint will notify the coach and the ASA of this response. Coaches can appeal such responses to Choicepoint and the National Office will review all such appears.
- If a coach is not approved, they will receive an adverse action letter from Choicepoint showing why they were not approved. Choicepoint will also notify the ASA National Office and the Local ASA Association will be subsequently notified.
- Any coach that is not automatically approved by Choicepoint has the right to appeal to Choicepoint to have their record cleared.
- If a coach is cleared by Choicepoint, their background check result will be automatically changed to a status of Green (approved) and the National Office will communicate this to the Local ASA Association.
